APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION TO UNDER-GRADUATE PROGRAMS FOR THE 2011/2012 ACADEMIC YEAR

Instructions:

- Applicants for admission into Bachelor's degree programs under the direct entry scheme must lodge their applications through the Central Admission System (CAS) of the Tanzania Commission for Universities (TCU) by the deadlines as announced by the TCU.
- Applicants for admission into Bachelor's programs under the equivalent entry scheme and for all Diploma programs must lodge their applications directly to the Office of the Academic Registrar at Mount Meru University (MMU) not later than May 31, 2011 so as to be considered for the August 2011 intake.
- Certified copies of 'O' level, 'A' level examination certificates; and transcripts of certificates, diplomas and other qualifications must be attached to this form. Please note that uncertified copies of academic documents will not be accepted. At registration originals shall be required.
- All academic records in a language other than English must be accompanied by a certified English translation.
- Each application must be accompanied by a Tshs 20,000/= application fee. You may pay this fee in cash at the University's Finance Office or at any of the University's bank accounts shown at the end of this form. If you pay through the bank, enclose the bank slip together with the application form.
- Incomplete applications will not be processed.

Admission Requirements:

Direct Entry into Bachelor's Degree Programs (for applicants of MMU's Bachelor's degree programs who would apply through the CAS of the TCU)

- At least two principal passes at the 'A' level secondary school education examination with a total of not less than 4.5 points whereby, A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2, E=1, S=0.5 and F=0.

Equivalent Entry into Bachelor's Degree Programs

1. At least *three* credits or *five* passes in approved subjects including English Language at the "O" level secondary school education examination; **and**
2. A relevant accredited diploma of not less than second class, or credit or average of "B" grade.

Direct Entry into Diploma Programs

1. At least *three* credits or *five* passes in approved subjects including English Language at the "O" level Certificate of Secondary Education; **and**
2. At least *one* good principal pass and two subsidiaries in appropriate subjects at the 'A' level secondary school education examination with a total of not less than 3.5 points whereby, A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2, E=1, S=0.5 and F=0.

Equivalent Entry into Diploma Programs

1. At least *three* credits or *five* passes in approved subjects including English Language at the "O" level secondary school education examination; **and**
2. A certificate relevant to the program applied for with a minimum Grade Point Average of 3.0, or its equivalent.
